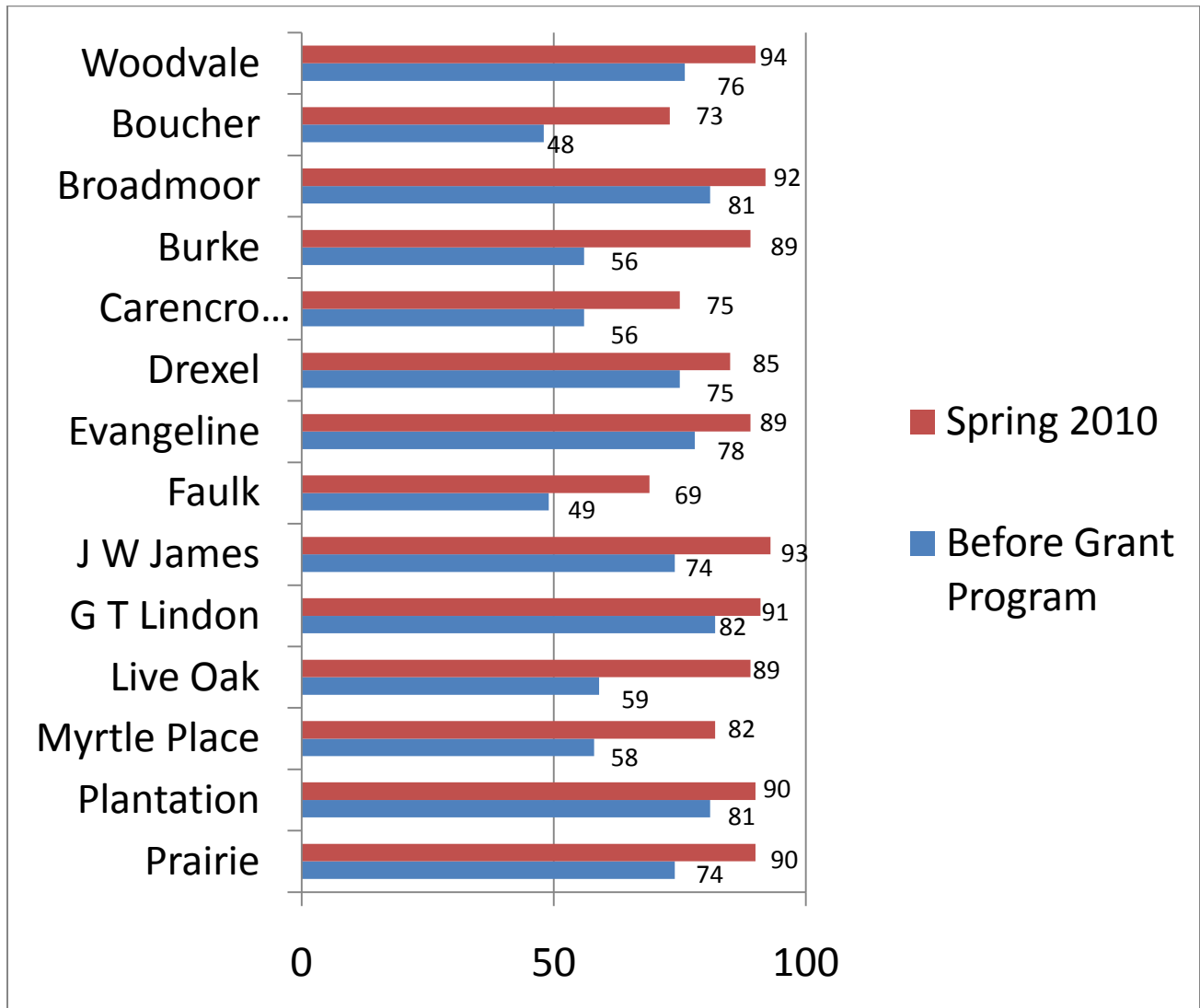


“LEF Helps Educators Close the Achievement Gap in Reading!”

Year Three Results show gains in the percentage of students reading on or above grade level!

Goal: To improve reading scores among K-3 “at risk” students in Lafayette Parish public schools by providing leveled textbooks for reading instruction and practice.

Of the 14 schools 9 reported 89%-94% of their 2nd graders are reading on or above grade level, while 2 reported above 80% of their students were on or above and 3 reported below 80%. (Results compare the percentage of students reading on or above grade level)



Through this program the “at risk” schools have reached the same level or exceeded the following schools that were not considered “at risk” at the time of funding.
